

HELPFUL HINTS

Welcome to the USCTI Fall Institute Meeting at the lovely Bacara Resort and Spa. Here are a couple helpful hints and suggestions about the area to make your stay more enjoyable.

- Please know that the beach at Bacara is a public beach, so you will be sharing the space with nearby residents.
- The beach has naturally occurring tar that seeps from the sand, it is recommended that you wear shoes while walking on the sand, or you will acquire some tar on the bottom of your feet. This is more evident on warmer days.
- Your resort fee includes a bottle of wine, water, in-room coffee served each morning upon request, wireless internet, and use of the spa and fitness facilities.
- There is a wine tasting room in the courtyard of Bacara, serving Foley Family wines. These wines include Kuleto Estate, Chalk Hill Estate, Sebastiani and Lancaster Estate and can be shipped to your home if you wish to purchase them. The tasting room is open 12pm-7pm, Sunday-Thursday and 12pm-8pm, Friday-Saturday.
- With the Santa Ynez Mountains nearby, there are multiple hikes to choose from. For an easy-going hike with a great view, check out Inspiration Point. If you're feeling adventurous, the 3 Pools Beyond 7 Falls hike is much more rigorous, but the pools at the end make it all worthwhile.
- There are nearly 30 different types of whales and dolphins that inhabit the Santa Barbara Channel during different parts of the year, making these waters some of the world's best for whale watching. Check with the Bacara concierge for more information on where and when to go.
- Santa Barbara is home to more than 125 wineries. If you choose to visit them, please see the concierge for maps or recommended tours and transportation.
